

**Uffington Parish Council
Meeting
Monday 10th December 2018**

MINUTES

1. **Chairman's Welcome.** The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting.
2. **Declarations of Pecuniary Interest;** There were none at this point
3. **Present** Councillor L Padmore-Chairman; Councillor P Daimond-Vice-chairman; Councillor R Davies; Councillor E Strawbridge; Councillor A Blake; Shropshire Councillor L Picton L Pardoe clerk to the council and J Jordan from Sundorne Estates.
4. **Public Session.** There were no members of the public to speak
5. **Police Report:** Please note these will now be done bi-monthly due to PC Walton's workload. They would be forwarded to members when received by the clerk and put on the website for the public to see. Members reported that there had been visits from the Speed Control vehicle and that several people had been caught speeding on camera.
6. **Council to agree minutes of meeting held on 12th November 2018;** it was agreed that these were a true and accurate record of the meeting; proposed by Councillor L Padmore seconded by Councillor P Daimond and agree by all members present.
7. **Clerk to report on matters from the minutes not covered elsewhere on the agenda.** The clerk reported that she had attended a meeting of the Town & Parish Council Forum at the Shirehall and been able to speak to Steve Brown, Head of Highways at Shropshire Council, who had agreed to attend the Parish Council meeting in January to speak to members on the Sundorne Roundabout. She had contacted all the prospective sponsors and explained the situation to them and invited them to attend the January meeting to hear what Steve Brown has to say and possibly contribute to the discussion.
8. **To receive Reports from Shropshire Councillor L Picton;** Councillor Picton had also spoken to Steve Brown about the roundabout and asked him to bring some proposals to the January meeting.
There are likely to be Boundary reviews in 2021 and this may lead to a reduction in the number of parish councils.
The financial situation is still in a bad way although Shropshire Council has received some £7.3 million for highways.
Councillor Picton wished all members of the Parish Council a Merry Christmas and left the meeting after making her report.
